## Visitor Information

The following information is designed to assist visitors attending a performance at the Hunter Theatre.

### **Buying Tickets**

Tickets are **only** available to purchase online by clicking this link <https://www.trybooking.com/BQTUB>

Your tickets will be emailed directly to you and must either be printed or shown on your mobile device for scanning before entry to the auditorium. Please allow enough time for this before the show starts. The Box Office will open one hour before the performance begins.

Please note there are no Refunds/Exchanges on tickets purchased.

### **Access/Parking**

Hunter Theatre is located on the grounds of Hunter School of the Performing Arts. Access to the Theatre is via Gate 3 on Cameron Street, Broadmeadow. Parking is available on the streets surrounding the Theatre with limited parking available in the carpark in front of the Theatre (only available outside of school times). Wheelchair access is via a ramp at the front of the Theatre and lifts are available inside the foyer for seating in the back row.

**All performers must be dropped off and picked up from the stage door at the back of the Theatre. Please note that access to backstage is not permitted by audience members and performers are not permitted into the foyer area once doors have been opened (approximately 1 hour before performance begins). Performers will use the toilets located in the dressing rooms at backstage.**

Once the show begins, the lower doors to the auditorium will be locked and access will be available through the doors at the top of the stairs. To limit disruption to the performers and audience, if you need to leave the theatre auditorium during the show, please exit and re-enter via the doors at the top of the stairs.

### **Facilities**

Toilets are available on the ground floor of the Theatre – accessible from the foyer behind the café. The Hunter Café is generally open and sells tea/coffee and a variety of snacks, please note that no eftpos facilities are available at the café.

### **First Aid/Safety**

A first aid kit is available in the Box Office (foyer level) and is equipped with standard first aid supplies, Ventolin and an Epi-pen. Basic first aid will be administered and an ambulance called if necessary.

If an evacuation alarm sounds follow directions from Theatre staff, evacuate the building, proceed to the assembly area, and do not re-enter until advised to do so. There are multiple exits all clearly marked with signage.
