



SPORT DEVELOPMENT



It's been a busy few months for Sport Development and we are very excited about new things that are coming into fruition!

We are continuing to receive new requests for assistance from schools wanting to get involved in FISAF Sport Aerobics and we are working with them on making this happen.

We have been discussing different options available with them before establishing a plan of action. Our support is always tailored to each school's specific needs and includes assistance/advice with:

- Come & Try/ Team Selection sessions
- Communication with parents
- Sample template documents
- Financial assistance with materials
- Costume design and sourcing shoes, socks, etc.
- Navigating their first event.

Following our development trip to Victoria in November, we have welcomed a number of new schools to FISAF and are now assisting them with their co-curricular programs, HPE curriculum units and vacation care programs!

Development of new education units is underway with the first one on FISAF Judging set for release in May. It will be especially helpful to new/junior coaches who wish to better their understanding of the different judge roles, what they look for, and how the ranking system works.

We have also continued looking at process/system improvements that relates to how we can better support our members, clubs and schools, as well as how we can improve our events, and administration processes and communication. Our aim is to lead the way as our community continues to grow.

GEMMA MACMILLAN

Gemma is a FISAF Australia Head Judge, a FISAF International Judge, and a member of the FISAF Australia Technical Committee. She is also an integral part of the development of our Pre-Choreographed packages each year that School and Elementary Stream athletes use.
