GOLDCOAST.

LOCATION:

Gold Coast Sports and Leisure Centre 296 Nerang Broadbeach Road, Carrara QLD 4211, Australia.

VENUE ACCESS:

Enviable, easily-reached location

- 50 minutes from Brisbane Airport
- 30 minutes from Gold Coast Airport
- 15 minutes from Broadbeach
- 4 minutes from M1
- Adjacent to Nerang train station: Three minutes by shuttle or 15-minute walk

Extensive parking facilities

The Gold Coast Sports and Leisure Centre has 400 undercover parking spaces (Green & Orange) with an additional 1100 external spaces available within the Precinct.

TUESDAY, THURSDAY - SUNDAY:

Orange & Green Carpark – located underneath the Centre will be available Purple Carpark (Overflow) – available Red Carpark – available

WEDNESDAY PARKING:

Please note there will be parking changes at Gold Coast Sport & Leisure Centre on the Wednesday 27th August due to an AFL match occurring at the Stadium and a busy precinct. It is recommended you allow extra travel time on this day.

Orange & Green Carpark – located underneath the Centre will be available Purple Carpark (Overflow) – will be open and available Red Carpark – unavailable

SPECTATOR TICKETS:

Spectator tickets for this event will be **sold online only**, via **Ticketebo.com**. Online ticket sales will remain open online throughout the event and can be purchased at any time *until sold out*.

Important Notes:

- There is no allocated seating at this venue, all seating is general admission first-in-first-served basis.
- Children 3 years & under may attend for free with a ticketed adult, however they must not take up a
 physical seat.
- Tickets will be available online FROM TUESDAY 19th August @ 9 AM
- Tickets can be purchased in the following ways:
 - CLUB EVENT PASSES: <u>TUESDAY FRIDAY ONLY</u>
 - 1-DAY EVENT PASS
 - These allow for access for 1 DAY only
 - If you have children competing across the multiple club days, or you wish to spectate
 multiple club days, you will need to buy separate tickets for each day you wish to
 attend
 - CLUB 4-DAY EVENT PASS For Tuesday Friday Competition Days Only.
 - An event pass is available for any spectators who wish to attend multiple 'club' event days
 - This event pass allows for access to the event from Tuesday 26th Friday 29th August ONLY
 - IMPORTANT: Club 4-day event pass wristbands MUST remain attached at all times whilst attending the event
 - Normal wristbands rules & guidelines apply regarding wristbands which are removed & or tampered with – see below for details
 - If you <u>do not</u> wish to keep your wristband on overnight you should instead purchase 1-day event passes.
 - SCHOOL EVENT PASSES: SATURDAY SUNDAY ONLY
 - O PER DAY PASS
 - These are sold PER DAY only
 - If you have children competing across the multiple school days, or you wish to spectate multiple school days, you will need to buy separate tickets for the relevant days
 - SCHOOL 2-DAY EVENT PASS For Saturday & Sunday Competition Days <u>Only</u>
 - An event pass is available for any spectators who wish to attend multiple 'school' event days
 - This event pass allows for access to the event from Saturday 30th Sunday 31st August ONLY
 - <u>IMPORTANT:</u> School 2-day event pass wristbands <u>MUST</u> remain attached at all times whilst attending the event
 - Normal wristbands rules & guidelines apply regarding wristbands which are removed & or tampered with – see below for details
 - If you <u>do not</u> wish to keep your wristband on overnight you should instead purchase per session event passes.

IMPORTANT!

- **Entered athletes** are welcome to attend <u>all sessions/days</u>, free of charge, provided that their 'Participant' wristband remains intact.
 - IMPORTANT: Event wristbands MUST remain attached at all times whilst attending the event.
- **Registered coaches** will receive a participant band for the days that they are attending as a coach:
 - Elementary, National & International Stream Coaches will receive a band that allows for access for Tuesday – Friday <u>ONLY</u>
 - School Stream Coaches will receive a band that allows for access for Saturday & Sunday only
 - IMPORTANT: Event wristbands MUST remain attached at all times whilst attending the event.

SPECTATOR WRISTBAND COLLECTION & EVENT ENTRY:

- Please print your receipt and ticket information *or* have it ready to go on your phone to bring with you on the day.
- On arrival, please queue at the 'TICKET/WRISTBAND COLLECTION' desk, in front of the Hall 1 (DOOR B) entrance doors and have the above items ready.
- The QR Code on your ticket/s will be scanned by a venue staff member, after which you will be given your applicable event pass wristband (depending on your purchase)
 - o You will be able to collect the wrist band/s under your booking for that particular day only
 - o It is essential that everyone puts their wristbands on before entering the hall. There will be ushers at the door checking these.
 - Wristbands must remain attached at all times.
 - Wristbands are non-transferable
 - Any wristband that is removed or tampered with will immediately become void, and a new pass will need to be purchased
 - Staff have the right to refuse entry to any spectator whose wristband has been tampered with
 - Multi day Event Passes: If you <u>do not</u> wish to keep your wristband on overnight you should instead purchase 1-day event passes.
- If you have purchased multiple per day or per session event passes, you will need to queue, have your ticket information scanned (QR CODE) and receive your new event pass wristband, <u>each day</u>
- Spectators will **not** be able to sign in and collect day pass wristbands for multiple days at a time.



CHILD SAFETY & SUPERVISION

During this event, there will be other non-FISAF activities running simultaneously at the venue. This means that there will be people inside the venue who are **NOT** there to be part of our event. This may include (but is not limited to) other athletes, spectators, staff, and members of the general public. FISAF Australia does not have exclusive use of facilities such as toilets, food vendors etc.

FISAF Australia is <u>NOT</u> responsible for the supervision of children in and around the venue throughout the event. It is <u>strongly recommended</u> that coaches provide extremely clear instructions to parent/carers and athletes regarding drop-off and collection times, and procedures related to supervision expectations and responsibilities.

Only FISAF Australia staff, registered athletes and coaches are permitted into warm-up and backstage areas. At no time are parents/carers and other persons permitted in these areas at any time throughout the event. In the event that a parent/carer needs to get an item to their child in these areas, they must ask a FISAF staff member to organise this with the child's coach.

PROGRAM:

Please be advised that the programs will most definitely change between the time of the first release and the event day due to withdrawals and potential double ups etc. Our team will do their best to keep the event running to schedule, but unforeseen circumstances can cause the event to run ahead or behind schedule.

Note: Make sure you refresh the web page **prior** to clicking on any linked documents to ensure your device is loading the most recent program.

FOOD & DRINKS:

There is a café located in the foyer of the venue, which will be open for the majority of event hours. Food & drink is allowed to be consumed within the hall; however, we would greatly appreciate it if you can please take all of your rubbish with you upon departure.

The food & beverage suppliers at this venue **do not** accept cash – card only.

<u>Please Note:</u> There is a strict venue rule, that there is to be no external food or drink brought into the venue at any time.

VIDEOGRAPHY:

Similar to previous years, the 2025 FISAF Australia National Championships will provide a digital video service to each athlete. Events HD is a video production company that has been creating imaginative and professional Videos/DVDs for the past 10 years.



This exceptional service will give each Club/School access to their entire club/school routines! The cost of this service has been included in all Club/School Nationals entry fees.

SOCIAL MEDIA:

WARM UP AREAS:

The main warm up area for this event is located within Hall 1, behind the staging area.

IMPORTANT: Schools & Clubs are **NOT** permitted to use the foyer as a warm up space.

<u>Please note:</u> Only teachers, coaches and competitors will be permitted within the warm up area. Parents may <u>NOT</u> enter this area at any time. Loud and disruptive behaviour backstage will not be tolerated, and all dressing rooms should be kept in a tidy manner.

We request that each athlete/team keeps a close eye on the program and ensures they are back stage, ready to perform at least 5 performance items prior to theirs.

Remember - Programs can run ahead or behind schedule.



PARTICIPANT REGISTRATION:

The participant registration desk will be located at DOOR D within the venue foyer.

TUESDAY – FRIDAY

JUDGES

- On arrival at the competition, all judges must <u>individually</u> visit the 'Participant Registration' area to collect their wristbands.
- Your wristband MUST remain on your arm throughout the duration of the event
- Judges only need to register once at the event not each day that they are attending.

CLUB COACHES

- On arrival at the competition, all coaches must individually visit the 'Participant Registration' area to collect their wrist bands.
- All participating coaches (including attending school principals & staff) must have a current FISAF Australia membership
 - If your name is not on the printed coach registration list, you will be required to register online before being given your event wristband & coach lanyard.
- Your wristband MUST remain on your arm throughout the duration of the event.
- Club Coaches only need to register once at the event not each day that they are attending (Applicable to Tues – Fri Only)

ATHLETES

- On arrival at the competition, all club athletes must **individually** visit the 'Participant Registration' area to collect their wristbands.
- Your wristband <u>MUST</u> remain on your arm throughout the duration of the event
- Athletes only need to register once at the event not each day that they are attending (Applicable to Tues – Fri Only)

SATURDAY & SUNDAY

JUDGES

- On arrival at the competition, all judges must <u>individually</u> visit the 'Participant Registration' area to collect their wristbands.
- Your wristband MUST remain on your arm throughout the duration of the event
- Judges only need to register once at the event not each day that they are attending.

SCHOOL STREAM COACHES

- On arrival at the competition, all coaches must individually visit the 'Participant Registration' area to collect their wrist bands.
- All participating coaches (including attending school principals & staff) must have a current FISAF Australia membership
 - If your name is not on the printed coach registration list, you will be required to register online before being given your event wristband & coach lanyard.
- Your wristband MUST remain on your arm throughout the duration of the event.
- School Stream coaches only need to register once at the event not each session that they
 are attending (Applicable to Sat Sun Only)
- School Stream coaches are to arrive 10 mins prior to their chosen meeting time to collect your own coach band & your <u>school's registration pack</u>.
- School Stream coaches are to meet with your athletes/teams, away from the 'Participant Registration' area, to distribute wristbands. Please do not gather in front of any foyer entry doors as this will cause unnecessary congestion. We suggest meeting your parents and athletes out on the grass area outside the main foyer.

SCHOOL STREAM ATHLETES

- School Stream athlete <u>DO NOT</u> need to individually register upon arrival Coaches will be provided with all their athlete wristbands
- Note: Each school may have different set arrival times (as set by the school).
 - Please ensure you understand your specified arrival time & location PRIOR to arrival
- Your wristband MUST remain on your arm throughout the duration of the event



IMPORTANT:

- **Entered athletes** are welcome to attend <u>all sessions/days</u>, free of charge, provided that their 'Participant' wristband remains intact
 - o <u>IMPORTANT:</u> Event wristbands <u>MUST</u> remain attached at all times whilst attending the event
- Registered coaches will receive a participant band for the days that they are attending as a coach:
 - Elementary, National & International Stream Coaches will receive a band that allows for access for Tuesday – Friday <u>ONLY</u>
 - o School Stream Coaches will receive a band that allows for access for Saturday & Sunday only
 - o <u>IMPORTANT:</u> Event wristbands <u>MUST</u> remain attached at all times whilst attending the event.

Registration Times:

Please refer to the event program for each day's opening registration times. Athletes, coaches & judges can arrive at any time *after* the specified opening registration times.

PRESENTATIONS & MARSHALLING:

Prior to each presentation we ask all athletes to start Marshalling backstage in their club or school groups. Each Club/School will be introduced on stage one at a time; to gain acknowledgement from all spectators as well the moment being captured by our film crew.

Once all athletes have marshalled onstage, each competition section will be read out by the judges. As teams are awarded placings, athletes are to carefully & quickly, walk onto the stage area to collect their medals & pose for any photos. Athletes are to then quickly return to their seats.

Please Note: Presentations may take up to 45-60 minutes, following the judge review.
